A Strong Start to the Winter Water Season

Snowpack measuring above average from recent storms but a lot more is needed.

Early season winter storms have led to a favorable and above-average start to our snowpack in the Sierras and Colorado River Basin, both of which feed into EMWD's sources for imported water: the State Water Project and the Colorado River Aqueduct. The above normal snowpack conditions are a promising start to the season but we are not out of the drought just yet. Consecutive storms of above-average rain, snow, and runoff are needed to bring our water supplies back from this extreme years-long drought, which is why it's important to always Stay WaterWise. 

How to Use Your MyAccount Tools




MyAccount allows you to pay your bill quickly and efficiently but did you know it also helps you manage your usage?

Let's take a closer look at some of the tools available to you...






Once logged in you'll see your account details, including your current bill and due date, any balance remaining from a previous bill, and if you are enrolled in auto payments.




View your recent bill under Bills & Payments to verify that your Water Budget/Sewer Block Data matches your current household size and landscaped area.





Compare water usage hourly or daily and see into the future with water budget forecast. See personalized graphs based on your recent consumption and historical weather conditions.

Walk With the Birds



EMWD hosts FREE Bird Walks on the second Saturday of each month during the migratory season -October through April. The familyfriendly tours, led by experienced birding guides, walk guests around the marshy wetlands to view unique resident and migratory birds.

EMWD's wetlands facility was constructed as a pilot project to assist in the treatment of wastewater from the San Jacinto Valley Regional Water Reclamation Facility. The 60-acre wetlands is now home to EMWD's award winning education program and offers a lush habitat for migratory fowl, shore birds, and raptors along the Pacific Flyway.

How do I sign-up for paperless billing?

Paperless billing with eBill is an easy and convenient way to access and store your monthly billing statements. View your bill from any location, any time of day, from your smart phone, tablet, or desktop computer. Follow the simple steps below to activate eBill and start paperless billing:

- 1. Login at myaccount.emwd.org
