Subject: EMWD Project Update – Construction Near Your Residence

Dear Neighbor:

On behalf of Eastern Municipal Water District (EMWD), we would like to update you about on-going construction activities that have and will take place over the next several months near your residence in the City of Moreno Valley (City).

In late 2020, EMWD began construction on the Perris North Groundwater Program (Program), which will provide long-term water quality and supply benefits to the region. The Program includes several projects throughout the City, with many phases of work, including a few near your neighborhood.

EMWD is pleased to provide you with the following updates on each component of the Program:

- **Wells 65 and 66 – Along Ironwood Avenue; between Heacock Street and Nita Drive**
 - Project Update: Crews are performing on-going work to construct the piping, structure, and motors needed to operate these wells.

- **Wells 206 and 207 – Perris North Groundwater Treatment Facility**
 - Location: Along Perris Boulevard; between Cottonwood Avenue and Bay Avenue
 - Project Update: Crews are performing on-going work to construct the piping, structure, motors, and treatment facilities needed to operate these wells.

- **Well 208 – Along Santiago Drive at the City of Moreno Valley Corporate Yard**
 - Project Update: Crews anticipate beginning work on constructing the piping, structure, and motors needed to operate this well beginning in late-February 2024.

- **Well 209 – Along Los Cabos Drive at Victoriano Park**
 - Project Update: The work at this site is broken up into two phases:

- **Phase I – COMPLETED:** The affected area at the park has been restored per City standards.
- **Phase II –** Crews are performing on-going work to construct the piping, structure, and motors needed to operate the well.
- **Pipeline Projects:** This work is being completed in phases to help minimize impacts to the community.
 - **Phase I – COMPLETED:** Primarily along Sweet Grass Drive and Flaming Arrow Drive
 - Project Timeline: Spring 2021 – Fall 2021
 - **Phase II – CONSTRUCTION ON-GOING**
 - Location: Primarily along Kitching Street
 - Project Update: Crews are about **81% completed** with the project. Work has neared completion on Kitching Street and will soon transition to Gentian Avenue, Patricia Street, and Santiago Drive before finishing up at Iris Avenue and Los Cabos Drive.
 - **Phase III – CONSTRUCTION STARTING SOON**
 - Location: Primarily along Perris Boulevard
 - Estimated Construction Start: Mid – 2024
- **Series of Monitoring Wells**
 - Project Update: Locations and timeline are being finalized; more information will be provided in the coming months.

Traffic control measures will be in place, as approved by the City, including flag operators to help direct traffic in the construction zones. EMWD asks that motorists please use extra caution for the safety of our work crews and the surrounding community.
